Hopefully you will have received an email or a phone call to explain the results of presenting the accounts and the 2022/23 budget to the AGM. Just in case you haven't here is a summary.

The accounts show that we spent about £1,000 keeping you in touch during Covid which is offset against the reserve as expected. We haven't been increasing our membership fee each year to keep up with inflation and those losses over the years before Covid have now caught up with us. The budget shows that 2022/23 has a predicted loss of £1,500 depending on the number of members and attendances. If we don't do something the club will be bankrupt in less than 3 years. To spread the financial burden of increases it was agreed at the AGM to do as other clubs do and have an entry fee of £2 for members so that the membership increase can be reduced from the £69 needed. After much debate at the AGM a fee of £45 up from £39 was suggested. The committee debated this further and agreed to go with this figure.

We know we have lost some members for various reasons mostly due to health issues. So, after the membership payment months of March and April are complete and we've had a couple more months to see the trend of attendances, we will review the situation. This may mean that we must plan to reduce the number of demonstrators next year or not have to increase the membership as much as expected next year. We'll keep you posted.

To add interest and raise some funds we are starting a couple of new things. In April we hope to start a Bring and Buy Book and Jigsaw stall run by Sheila please bring your donations to the table at the back of the hall. Hopefully we will also have a spring plant sale as well.

Please continue to support your club, so many have closed, and we don't want to join them. Any ideas are welcome please have a chat with Chris M or any member of the committee. Speaking of which Sue Bennett has taken a sabbatical due to work pressures and Joan Green has re-joined the committee. Thank you for reading this long "summary".
